#### Librarian's Report

### STEM Specialist's Report

- I. Daine Bedell is back at Blakely teaching Science. STEM was a pilot in 2014-2015 funded by Bainbridge Schools Foundation and it is being implemented in all the elementary schools 2015-2016.
- II. Science curriculum will focus on Life Science, Physical Science, Earth & Space Science, and Engineering Design.
- III. Elementary Engineering by Grade:
  - a. First Science Inspired by Nature
  - b. Second Designing Walls
  - c. Third Earthquake Resistant Buildings
  - d. Fourth Rockets and Rovers
- IV. Focuses of Science at Blakely by Grade:
  - a. Kindergarten Exploring Design, Pushes and Pulls, will work with Makedo & Rolobox.
  - b. First Light and Sound, will work with Squishy Dough to create sculptures with circuits.
  - c. Second Changing Earth, will work with Maker Studio using gears, propellers and winches.
  - d. Third Forces and Interactions, will work with Bristle Bots, toothbrush heads and motors.
  - e. Fourth Energy Conversion, will work with Little Bits and Makey Makeys. Showed a short video of Makey Makeys.
- V. Presented the idea of having a Maker Fair instead of a Science Fair at Blakely.
